FACTS OF GROCERY CARD PROGRAM

- 1 Program funded by St. Martha's Knights of Columbus & Catholic Women's League
- 2 Grocery cards are pre-purchased in bulk
- 3 A minimum of 4 -10.5 % profit is earned by our program
- 4 Profit of program to help parish ministries and related initiatives (see back)
- 5 Grocery cards never expire
- 6 Grocery cards entitle you to discounts, More Rewards points, Air Miles, gas coupons, Superstore points – just like any other payment method
- 7 100% of your investment is returned to you
- 8 Cards sold at most weekend masses

To be successful we encourage all parishioners to participate

WHAT CAN BE PURCHASED

- 1 Grocery cards from 7 major Food Stores (Save-on-Foods; Safeway/Sobeys/IGA; Superstore/No Frills/Real Canadian Wholesale)
- 2 Card denominations of \$100, \$50 and \$25 are available
- 3 Can be purchased with cash, cheques, debit/credit card; Visa * & Mastercard* accepted (* fee applies), or e-transfer.
- 4 A 2% fee is charged for credit cards sales. This is cost recovery as we are charged this fee.
- 5 E-transfer purchase: Make an e-transfer payment by emailing knightscards9280@gmail.com . . . Orders received & paid for by Thursday, will be available for quick pickup at our Grocery Card stand at the Masses on the following Saturday / Sunday.
- 6 Very easy to use in stores as no pin numbers are needed & receipt shows balance on card.

HOW TO USE GROCERY CARD

- 1 Buy your weekly groceries; cannot be used to buy gas
- 2 Give to family members as gifts
- 3 Donate cards to organizations
- 4 Use for special occasions, such as birthday gifts
- 5 Use cards to buy groceries for private and business social functions
- 6 Businesses can buy cards as gifts, awards or incentives for their employees
