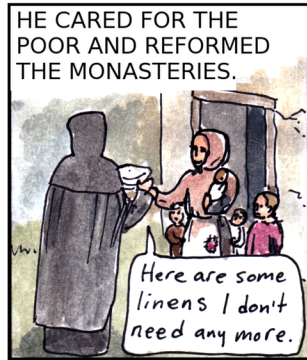
SAINT WOLFGANG BECAME A BENEDICTINE AND WAS ORDAINED A PRIEST.



HE WAS SENT TO TEACH THE MAGYARS, WHO WERE PAGAN WARRIORS THAT LIVED NEARBY.



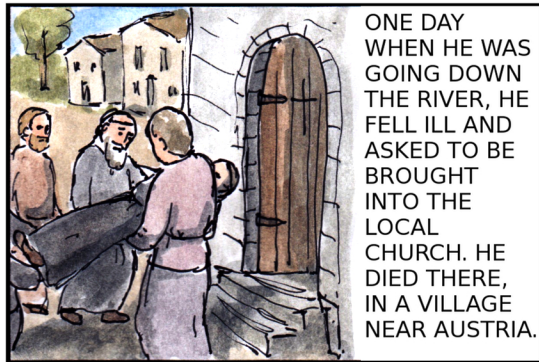
Wolfgang will make an excellent bishop!
